Another exciting year at Blakeley BoatWorks with a milestone achievement!

As of November 18th, we achieved 1 year without a Lost Time Accident; more than that, we achieved 1 year without any serious accidents or incidents at all.



During the year, the team also completed 52 Formal Safety Observations, 47 Corrective Near Misses, 14 Coachings, 117 Positive Safety Recognitions, 11 Shipyard Wide Safety Meetings, continued our bi-monthly Safety Team Meetings, completed over 50 Safety training classes and modules, hosted 2 shipyard reviews with AEU and member shipyards, as well as starting our AEU Leadership training and development program with our Supervisory staff. In addition, there was an untold number of people to people interactions, team members looking out for each other, and that quick quiet safety reminder on tool guards, housekeeping, fall protection or PPE that helps keep everyone in the game.

Safety is each person, on each team, from each department – staying focused one day at a time.

People need to be renewed and refreshed because they are our most valuable asset, and we all know that the best safety device is a careful worker.

# C/PA 3rd Quarter Safety Winners





they work, I don't recall women




